"Onward and Upward" Is a good mantra for 2023. With the worst of the pandemic behind us, we continue to adjust to a world that is definitely different. We have gained a new appreciation for human connection, even as human communication has become far more digitalized. We have had to shift the way we approach most things in our lives. At NAMI Mercer we are wholly engaged in this balancing act!

After launching several new programs in 2022, we turned our attention to refining and building on what we had started which is what I would like to highlight here. Compelling Conversations was offered to several faith communities and additional communicators were recruited and trained. More sessions of WOW (Working on Wellness) were provided for our corporate partner, IPG Health, with employees logging in from across the country. Participants in The Empathy Network decided that meeting bi-monthly was simply not frequent enough, so the group is now gathering weekly. To address the burgeoning youth mental health crisis, we pivoted from NAMI's signature program, Ending the Silence, to a more interactive student-directed model, Let's Talk Mind Matters. And we dug into our new initiative, Collaboration for Caring Communities, bringing influencers from urban Trenton to the table so we could listen and learn from them. Phase II will involve a collaborative response to address the trauma that impacts this community on a daily basis.

We embrace the age-old wisdom - "the world changes and we have to change with It" but we could not do this without YOU! So, quite simply, friends, thank you, for being open- to possibilities, for adapting to change, and let us continue "Onward and Upward!"

Tanulies MAKING A DIFFERENCE

Family to Family

Two 8-session Family to Family classes were held. 32 families completed the course reporting greater feelings of empowerment, reduced anxiety, and improved coping and problem solving skills.

17SS Family Support Group

Through our partnership with Intensive Family Support Services (IFSS) under Oaks Integrated Care, 117 Family Support Group Meetings were held online or in a hybrid format, we helped hundreds of family members and friends experience less stress and improve family functioning through the development of better coping skills. The average participation per session numbered 16, individual consultations were also held.



The Parent Support Network

12 in-person meetings were held for parents/caregivers of youth under age 24. Participants openly shared their concerns and exchanged resources with a view towards helping their children become all they can be. Average participants per session were 4. The Youth Mental Health Project notified us they planned to cease operations which prompted us to bring this group in-house under the name *Just Parents* in November 2023.

PEEPS SHARING HOPE

Social Support Groups

Just Friends (35+)

49 people attended 12 Meet and Greets, 23 people attended 3 Planning Meetings. 15 in-person social activities were hosted including a play at Kelsey Theater, a trip to Grounds for Sculpture, Bowling/Billiards and Pizza, Movies, an Ice Cream Social, and visits to the Princeton Museum of Art the NJ State Museum/Planetarium, Shady Brook Farm, the Greek Festival, and Mercer County Park. Members also enjoyed lunches at Olive Garden and the Rt 1 Diner, as well as Halloween, Holiday, and New Year's Eve Parties. Total Participation: 549

Becoming Friends (18 -35)

Our social support group for the young adult crowd, was resurrected in October, 2023 beginning with 4 people attending a Meet & Greet. Subsequently, 5 in-person activities were held, headlined by movie days. Total Participation: 22.



Connection

43 peer-led hybrid meetings were held for participants to share challenges and accomplishments, offering encouragement and support to each other on the journey of recovery. Average participants per session were 4. 2 new assistant facilitators were added.

Empathy Network

24 In-person support group meetings were held with average attendance of 12 for those coping with depression. Participants reported feeling understood and encouraged by their peers, reducing their feelings of loneliness and improving their self-esteem.

Hearing Voices

A support group for those who hear voices or have other unusual sensory perceptions met twice monthly with an average attendance of 4. Participants welcomed having a safe space for speaking openly and honestly about their experiences and what helps them to cope.

Mending Mindsets

25 online support group meetings were held with average attendance of 4 for those coping with anxiety. Participants indicated a reduction in their symptoms, improved coping skills, greater motivation, and less Isolation.

Weight ≠ Worth

This support group for those who have an unhealthy preoccupation with food or body image was held in partnership with Counseling and Prevention Services (CAPS) on TCNJ's campus. 9 meetings were held in the fall 2023 with average meeting attendance of 5.

Communities PROMOTING WELLBEING

EMPOWED

Workplace Mental Health

Three six-week sessions of WOW (Working On Wellness) were held for employees from McCann/IPG Health all across the country with average attendance of 11. Participants discussed relevant topics and networked to promote greater wellbeing.



Next Gen Initiatives

Our youth became more astute about early warning signs of mental illness, learned how to access help for themselves or their friends, and developed greater empathy for those with mental health challenges.

NAMI Mercer's *Journey of Resilience* was presented to 68 students enrolled in Janssen's Bridge to Employment series for inner city youth and to 40 students enrolled In the Gear-Up program under the NJ Department of Education

700 students at West Windsor Plainsboro South HS were part of an online *Diversity, Inclusion, and Mental Health* presentation. Another 31 benefited from an *Ending the Silence* presentation.

238 students at Cinnaminson HS were part of our Inaugural *Let's Talk Mind Matters* program.


Warmline & Resource Hub

Helpline

454 inquiries were fielded by 7 Helpline specialists working inoffice or remotely (supported by staff). 294 of the inquiries or 64% were first-time contacts. Callers reported more knowledge, less stress, and a clearer path forward. 96% stated they would contact the Helpline again in the future for assistance.

Helpline +

Callers with more complex or intense needs received hundreds of hours of personalized assistance from experienced mental health advocates within our community with help navigating the mental health and/or criminal justice systems and resolve problems.





Award-Winning Actress, Political Activist & Advocate for Social Justice, and Global Humanitarian Ashley Judd was our special guest for our annual wellness conference. She engaged in a fireside chat facilitated by talented local playwright, David Lee White. Nearly 200 conference goers were inspired by the plenary session, educational workshops, *Compelling Conversations*, and a mini-concert culminating with the Judd's epic ballad of togetherness, *Love Can Build a Bridge*.

Toolkits

User-friendly tips & tools to address myriad mental health topics were provided to multiple audiences.



Community Education & Outreach

NAMI Mercer led 25+ community education events, including *Compelling Conversations*, reaching more than 1,000 people. Audiences Included faith communities, civic and social service organizations, law enforcement, college students, seniors, school personnel, sorority sisters, and neighborhood cohorts.

6,000+ is the number of people NAMI Mercer reached through our presence at wellness fairs, festivals, and community events all across the Capital County.

Collaboration for Caring Communities

We brought leaders and influencers from vulnerable and underserved communities In Trenton to the table to discuss their concerns and explore how we might be of assistance In promoting access to mental health resources. Trauma emerged as the overriding issue and next steps will involve engaging in collaborative partnerships to break down barriers and design education/support/outreach strategies that will work.




FOR TODAY & TOMORROW

NAMI Mercer was pleasantly surprised by the financial support we received from our community in 2023. We brought in a total of \$556,000 from all revenue sources, including individual donations and income from our fundraising activities, as well as our contract with Mercer County, contributions from corporations, foundations, and a very generous grant from NAMI National. We are thrilled with all of the new initiatives we are able to implement due to the tremendous financial support we received throughout the year. We also stayed within budget for all our operating expenses, allowing us to increase our net assets to \$593,338 as of year-end.


